PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

As a Canvasser for EHC, you will be expected to phone bank (cell phone provided) from a remote workspace of your choice and walk-in neighborhoods (keeping 6ft distance from others) such as Barrio Logan, Logan Heights, Sherman Heights, City Heights, and Mountain View and others for literature drop purposes (no door knocking). Ability to get yourself to neighborhoods or required locations on time. All necessary technology to work remotely will be provided.

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Bilingual preferred (Spanish or Vietnamese)
- Have a secure workspace (at home) to phone bank remotely
- Good communication skills
- Punctuality and good work ethic
- Commitment to the empowerment of communities
