COMMUNITY REPRESENTATION

Includes members from 8 neighborhoods (Barrio Logan, Logan Heights, Sherman Heights, Mt. Hope, Shelltown, Stockton, Grant Hill, and Southcrest).



COMMUNITY CONNECTION

Serves as a link between residents, community organizations, and project partners.



PROJECT OVERSIGHT

Provides follow-up and feedback throughout project implementation.



ALIGNMENT WITH COMMUNITY NEEDS

Ensures that the project's vision and values reflect residents' priorities.



OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE

Opportunity to participate in other committees to ensure projects completion and resident satisfaction



REGULAR MEETINGS

Meets at a minimum four times a year to evaluate progress and provide recommendations to the CSS.
